## Entry Requirements for International Fellowship Training Programmes in Ireland

To apply for the International Fellowship Training Programme in Ireland you must have:

- Completed your primary medical degree through English
- Completed a structured internship (equivalent to 'house officer' in some jurisdictions)
- Completed a four/five-year national Residency Programme and incorporated examinations (Saudi, Arab, Omani, Kuwaiti Board or FRCPath Part 1 for Pathology Specialties)
- Appropriate experience post-Residency training in your chosen specialty (as determined by the relevant Programme Director)
- Eligibility to be registered with the Irish Medical Council (Supervised Division)
- Sponsorship from your national body (we do not accept self-sponsored candidates) to cover your fees, salary and living expenses for the full duration of the programme
- Have an academic IELTS overall bandscore of 7.0 with no less than 6.5 in each of the four domains or grade B in OET
